Saturday July 2 :

Sunday July 3

The Mayor of Doesburg will welcome you in our city . In the afternoon we will visit several old historic buildings in the old city of Doesburg. Doesburg, located where the three provinces Achterhoek, Veluwe en Liemers meet, is widely known for its beautifully restored historic city centre and fortifications.

Monday July 4

During the daytime we have planned several outdoor activities like a GPS tour and a abseiling event. In the evening we will prepare the fare well party on Saturday 8 july

Tuesday July 5

We will visit a medieval castle and afterwards we will visit the world famous Kröller Müller Museum. The Kröller-Müller Museum boasts the second-largest Van Gogh collection in the world: almost 90 paintings and over 180 drawings. Furthermore, you will also find masterpieces by modern masters such as Claude Monet, Georges Seurat, Pablo Picasso and Piet Mondriaan.

Wednesday July 6

We will have a bike tour through the region. We will visit old windmills together with a guide.

Thursday July 7

We will visit the open air Museum. The Netherlands Open Air Museum is full of stories. They are hidden in the historic houses, mills and farmhouses you will find in the museum park, as well as in our work, lives, customs and traditions. We bring these stories - yours and ours - to life during a visit to the museum. Here you can immerse yourself in the past and get to know our history - as well as your own. In the afternoon we will visit the city of Arnhem where you can shop till you drop.

Friday July 8

During the day we can make preparations for the pied evening. In the evening we will follow a cooking workshop in Doesburg where you can prepare typical Dutch meals.

Saturday July 9

Because we don't know what the flight schedule will be for your trip back home we haven't planned anything on this day. The families where you have stayed will bring you back to Schiphol where you can say goodbye after a hopefully very inspiring week.
