Tuesday. July 31 st	»Travel« back to the Iron Age (500 BC – 750 AC) Lodging in the farm houses. Workshops and cooking. Evening with bonfire, singing and storytelling. Overnight stay in the Iron –Age houses at »Vingsted Historical Workshop«
Wednesday August 1 st	Workshops in the Iron-Age environment continued. Overnight stay in the Iron Age houses.
Thursday August 2 nd	Ending of the workshops in the Iron Age environment. Back to »Hærvejens Lejrskole«.
Friday August 3 rd	The Viking Ages (750 -1050 AC). »The Kings' Jelling« with the Runic Stones. Sail with a viking ship on lake Fårup.
Saturday August 4 th	2 by 2 at homestay with Rotary-members.
Sunday August 5 th	Bustrip to Ribe with visit to “Ribe Viking Center” and the old town of Ribe
Monday August 6 th	Canoing on “Gudenåen”
