**Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> July – Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> July**

Information for Campers

The Rotary Youth Exchange summer camp is an opportunity for young people, generally aged 16 – 17, to meet equivalents from other countries and exchange ideas and cultural values. It is found to be an excellent opportunity for developing international friendships and goodwill, which is one of Rotary's primary objectives. **The camp lasts two weeks from 14<sup>th</sup> July to 28<sup>th</sup> July 2018**

We ask you to arrange to travel so that you arrive on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2018 at Manchester / Liverpool airports or in some cases the railway station or bus station. You can arrive at any time that suits your journey, and your host family will come to meet you.

**If you have any problems with these travel dates and need to arrive (or depart) earlier or later, please contact John Shepley as soon as possible, so that we can make arrangements for you.**

It is important that you have a mobile phone with you and tell the host family the number so that you can get in touch in case of travel problems. DO NOT use all the battery, so that you can still make calls when you arrive!

Once your place on the Camp has been confirmed we will organise your host families for this visit. As soon as the details are finalised I will send you all the necessary information about your hosts including e-mail address and phone number etc. You can then make contact. You need to let your family know time and place of your arrival in England so they can be there to meet you. You should also tell them all the details regarding your journey home.

For the first four nights, you will stay at the home of your host family. You will have your own private room. During these first four days, you may choose to visit things in the Manchester area and other places in the North-west of England of interest to you. Your hosts generally like having days out, and you can go in small groups with the other campers who want to do the same things as you. Before arriving in England please tell your hosts some things about yourself and also any things that you like. This will help them plan some trips for you.

On the first Sunday after you arrive your hosts will take you out to the opening Sunday lunch when you will have your first opportunity of meeting all the other campers.

From Wednesday the 18<sup>th</sup> July to the end of the Camp the group stay together on a camp site at Petty Pool, Cheshire, and travel each day to activities organised by local Rotary Clubs. For the middle weekend of the camp, you will be going by boat to the Isle of Man, where you stay in a hostel with lots of outdoor activities by the sea.

The last Friday of the camp is a special occasion. All the campers and their host families meet up at Petty Pool for a farewell evening. We really hope that you will not have to leave early as the last night on Friday is very special.

On Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> July you will be taken back to the airport for your journey home.

Please note you should bring casual clothes such as jeans, t-shirts, shorts; together with strong footwear for walking/hiking and swimwear etc for sporting activities. It might also be useful to pack a light raincoat in case it rains and also a jumper or fleece in case it gets cool. Also if you play a musical instrument then you are invited to bring it with you (up to size of a guitar). Also CD's etc.

You should also be aware that smoking and alcohol are not allowed during the Summer Camp.
