If you need help to find the train or bus from airport (MUC) to Innsbruck we will help you – give us your flight number and the estimated time of arrival.  Transfer to/from the guest families to the airport/train station Innsbruck is organized by Rotary.
Participants:	Maximum number of participants: 16 - One boy or one girl from each country.  Final acceptation will be made according to the arrival order of applications!  No pre-reservations will be accepted without full application form!  The decision on acceptance or refusal of the candidate is strictly within the responsibility of the organising club.  Closing date: The organising club will inform applicants about the final decision by the end of March 2018.
Age:	Minimum age: 17 Maximum age: 20 Participants must be at least 17/at most 20 years old at the beginning of the camp!
